E.T. Wright is a well-known and prosperous farmer in this vicinity, died at his home four miles south of Princeton on Wednesday of last week. Bright's disease from which he suffered for some time, was the cause of death. Funeral services were held at the Baptist Church in this city, Thursday, being conducted by Rev. W. E. Kaufmann. Interment was in Princeton Cemetery.

Elijah T. Wright was born in Gallia County, Ohio December 24, 1856, being 58 year, 6 months and 13 days old at the time of his death. In 1872, he left that state with his parents for Indianapolis, Indiana, where they lived for three years. From there they went to Mercer County, Illinois and remained for two years. They came to this County in 1877, where he has since made his home.

He married in 1879 to Lucinda Lusk. To this union, eight children were born. Seven of these were living and were with their father during his late illness and at the time of his death. They are Arthur, Effie (deceased), Clarence, Lloyd, Clyde, Mrs. Edna Mason, Leona and Charles. All of the children are members of the Antioch Baptist Church but later united with the Methodist Protestant Church. He was also an honored member of the M. W. A.

During his suffering, which was at times tense, he was ever patient and talked calmly of his approaching death. He was a good man and his friends are numbered by his acquaintances.
