

Mrs. Lucinda M. Wright, 83 years old, died Thursday at her home near Princeton. The funeral was held Friday from the Methodist Church in this city, and was conducted by the Rev. A. C. Runge. Burial was made in the Princeton Cemetery.

Lucinda M. Lusk was born in Lindley Township April 28, 1860. She moved with her parents to Ohio in 1861, and remained there until the close of the war, when they moved to Mills County, Iowa. They made their home there for two years, after which they returned to Mercer County, MO.

She was united in marriage to Elijah Wright Jan. 19, 1879, and they became the parents of eight children, two having preceded their mother in death. Those who survive are Clarence E. Wright, Lloyd M. Wright, Clyde L. Wright, Edna A. Mason, Leona R. and Charles Lusk Wright. Mrs. Wright united with the United Brethren Church in 1873 during the time Rev. L. D. Collings was serving as pastor of the Collings Church. She later transferred her membership to the M. P. Church of which she was member at the time of her death.
